Covid 19 Guidelines for Coming to Church

There will be no change to our precautions in the winter season and with Covid still in our communities.

We ask everyone to sanitise hands on arrival and to wear a face covering. Face coverings should be worn when entering the church, moving around (e.g. coming up to receive Communion), when leaving the building and while singing hymns. *This is unless you are medically exempt or are under 11.* Face coverings can be removed while seated or may be kept on if you wish to. We will ensure that all who would like to, can be seated socially distanced in church. Anne-Marie

On Sundays we may register for **Trace and Test on arrival by either scanning the QR code using the phone app, or you will be recorded on the sheet at the door. All records are kept for 21 days, then securely disposed of.**
